Moureen Loyce (affectionately know as "Moffie") Trimble Sanders was born February 7, 1927, in Amarillo, Texas. She was the first of two children born to Joseph William and Cynthia Wake Trimble. Moureen grew up with her parents and sister Billie Jean in Tucumcari, New Mexico, where she also met Bill Sanders. They were married on March 23, 1947, and moved to California. From there, they moved to Artesia to raise their three daughters and later move to Albuquerque. She eventually moved to Roswell, where she strived to cheer on her grandchildren and great-grandchildren in every sport, rodeo, and life event she could.

Moureen's most admirable role was being a wife, mother, and grandmother, which became the focus and pride of her life. The most important activity outside of her home was her involvement as a lifetime member of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints (Strangite). In the Church she served various roles such as Treasurer well into her nineties. Moureen always encouraged her family to be strong in the Church and follow the teachings of Christ.

Moureen was a devout, compassionate and giving woman with a huge heart. Moureen served as Vice President of New Mexico Supply Company, her family-owned business. She enjoyed being an Artesia Bulldog Booster member for cheerleading and other school functions. She continued her love for volunteering for the schools, to help with her grandchildren's school activities and always volunteered to drive them where they needed to go after school. In her spare time Moureen was engaged in the community as a volunteer for Saint Mary's Hospital and Eastern New Mexico Medical Center Auxiliary. Moureen loved pets, e

specially her Boston Terrier pups and of course her turtles. Moffie's door was always open for family, friends, and especially her grandkids. They meant the world to her. As a homemaker, she loved to cook, visit with friends, and drink coffee. She also enjoyed spending time designing and building homes.

Moureen will be remembered for her tenacious love of her family and friends, amusing wit, amazing home cooking and hospitality, sense of humor, and selfless generosity. These gifts of compassion are more than learned behaviors. They were characteristics of her nature; her heart was full for service and her life was dedicated to being the best woman for her family.
