Adela was a very accomplished woman in our eyes. She was a victims advocate at the Roswell Refuge for battered adults helping the community feel protected. Social worker counseling helped provide and set up after care services for those still in need. Adela went on to work for the RISD; she started her career in the Special Education Department working with kids with disabilities. She would participate with students for several years in the special Olympics as well.

Adela went on to become the migrant resource and referral liaison, recruiter for federal progams. Adela was with the Roswell Independent School District for 12 years. Adela was part of a program that would work closely with all

schools in the community. The program would help provide warm jackets for the needy and winter, school supplies for kids that could not get it on time for school. She would organize several special events, speaking at events for multiple occasions for the Roswell community, Even coordinating several years of summer school.

Adela served her community, becoming a member of the pinata fest committee

bringing our raza together to celebrate our heritage. Adela went on to work for Children Youth & Families in the investigation and reunification department. She did this for 13 rewarding years. It was one of the many greatest accomplishments. Working with families to overcome diversity and be one whole family again. She touched many families with her generosity. Adela then made the decision to become her father Raymond Sr , Tillie Hidalgo's sole caregiver and biggest advocate. She took care of both until their last days, Adela always made sure all their needs were always met whole heartedly. They meant the absolute world to her.

Adela played a very big role in her grandchildren's lives. Adela was the only person her daughter Angelica co-parented with. It was because Adela her grandchildren were blessed with many unforgettable memories and deep knowledge. Alyssia, Maricruz, Karina, & Anthony are her greatest joys. They brighten her life every day. She loved them so dearly.

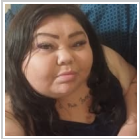
