He thrived in his studies and looked forward to completing his education at the ENMU campus in Portales. Unfortunately, due to his declining vision and inability to drive, he was unable to finish the final steps of his degree. Still his love of learning and education never ceased. In the years that followed, Adolfo dedicated himself fully to his greatest joy, spending time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Whether they were going to the library, grabbing a bite at McDonald's, exploring the flea market, visiting the pet store, taking a ride on the city bus or walking the railroad tracks behind the house, he made sure every moment was an adventure. His presence made everyday moments feel special. Even while undergoing dialysis and facing physical limitations, Adolfo remained active. He was often seen exercising, always pushing himself to get stronger, hoping to one day walk without any assistance. Adolfo will be remembered for his kind heart, quiet strength, and the gentle way he supported and uplifted those around him. His memory will continue to live on through the many lives he touched.

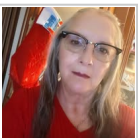
