Alice L. Andersen, age 89 of Roswell, NM, formerly of Fargo, ND died on Saturday, April 19, 2008 in the Mission Arch Care Center in Roswell. Alice was born October 9, 1918 in Fargo, ND to Peder & Margaret (Maggie) Peterson.

Alice graduated Moorhead State Teachers College 1942 with a B.S. in Education, English and Music. While in school she worked for the State Theatre and Kreskies. She moved to Hancock, MN where she taught in the public school and met her future husband, Norman Andersen. They were married on March 4, 1945 in the Norwegian Lutheran Church in Hancock, MN. They moved to Fargo around 1950. Norman preceded Alice in death December 4, 2007.

Alice worked for Minneapolis Moline and the Fargo Water Department until 1963 when they adopted their son, Michael. In the late '70's, she went to work for Fargo Cass Community Health as a Home Health Aide until her retirement in 1980.

In 1984, Norman & Alice moved to Roswell, NM where Alice enjoyed golfing, playing the organ, oil painting, was an avid reader and a faithful patron of the Roswell Public Library.

In addition to her husband, Norman, Alice was preceded in death by her parents, and sister Pearl Ardeth Nienaber.
