October 20, 1939 - June 16, 2016

Allan R. Cribbs died on June 23, 2016, at age 76, at Eastern New Mexico Hospital in Roswell, NM. He was born September 20, 1939, in Greensburg, PA, the son of Henry G. and Fronie Sarah Jane (Powell) Cribbs.

Allan graduated from New Kensington High School, Class of 1957. Following graduation, he enlisted and served in the U.S. Army from 1959 - 1962. After the service, he married his sweetheart, Jeanette Tiede, on October 12, 1962, and settled in El Paso, Texas. In 1979 he moved to Roswell, New Mexico.

Allan was a member of the Fraternal Order of the Eagles, No. 3187, of Roswell, since 1979, the American Legion and was a member of the Sheet Metal Workers Union, Local 49. Allan was a general contractor and owned A & C Specialties which included cabinet making and remodels. He was an artist and craftsman. He enjoyed gardening, woodworking and model making. He was an avid Dallas Cowboys and NASCAR fan.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers: David and Glenn Cribbs.
