Antonio "Tony" Torrez, a man who truly never met a stranger and filled every room with music and laughter, passed away peacefully on May 4, 2026—just six days shy of his 77th birthday. A lifelong resident of Roswell, Tony left behind a legacy of faith, family, and a rhythm that will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

A Life of Service and Devotion

Born on May 10, 1949, in Dexter, New Mexico, to Candido and Eulalia Torres, Tony grew up with a deep appreciation for his roots. He graduated from Hagerman High School in 1968 before answering the call to serve his country. In 1969, Tony joined the U.S. Army, serving overseas in Germany with honor and pride. Upon returning home, Tony built a life centered on love. He was married to Ysabel Torrez from February 5, 1972, until her passing on February 7, 1989. In a beautiful second chapter of life, he found his soulmate, Consuelo Mendiola Torrez, and the two were wed on July 7, 1990. Their union was a testament to enduring partnership and joy.

Tony was perhaps best known for the guitar in his hands and the song in his heart. An avid musician, he was a pillar of the St. Peter's Catholic Church choir, where his voice served as a bridge between the congregation and the divine. Beyond his music, Tony was the undisputed king of the "Tony joke." He was legendary for telling jokes that were objectively bad, yet his delivery and spirit made them undeniably funny. He was also well-known for his famous advice to everyone he loved: he wanted to make sure we all had our "Ducks in a row." Whether he was at church, buying his lottery scratchers, the casino in Ruidoso, or cheering for the Kansas City Chiefs, Tony's wisdom and humor left a mark on everyone he met.
