Funeral services will be held for Betty Finley, 80, of Roswell at 1 pm, Tuesday, November 27, 2012 at Bethel Baptist Church with Pastor Lamar Morin of Bloomfield, NM officiating. Burial to follow in South Park Cemetery. Betty went home to her Lord and Savior on Thursday, November 22, 2012.

Known to many as Betsy, Betty was born in Clifton, Texas, on January 13, 1932, to Bill and Birdie Carr. Her family relocated to a homestead northeast of Roswell where she spent her childhood years. After her family moved to Roswell, Betty graduated from Roswell High School in 1949. Shortly after graduating, Betty married her first husband Alban Frislid, who died while serving in the Air Force. They lived at several different bases prior to his death. Betty returned to Roswell with her children in January, 1965. She married David Finley on December 7, 1968. Betty was very active with her children, serving as a Girl Scout and Boy Scout leader. In addition, she was a very active member of the church, Bethel Baptist, where she served as many years as the financial secretary for Women On Mission as well as participation in several other church groups. As one of many volunteer activities, she was dedicated to bringing a smile and a warm touch to church members who were unable to attend services.

Betty also worked for her church as a part-time secretary for several years. Her activities with Bethel Baptist brought many great friends into her life, whom she treasured dearly.

Betty enjoyed bowling and square dancing with her husband, David, for many

years. She was an avid gardener, and she loved to read and bake. She was a lover of all animals, but she was especially fond of cats, and had an extensive collection of all things cats.

Betty's beautiful smile and warm hugs will always be remembered by all whose lives were blessed by her presence.

Those left to cherish her memory are her husband David Finley of the family home; her son Terry Frislid and his wife, Sandy of Roswell; her daughters, Janice Frislid of Roswell, Elaine Finley of Carlsbad, NM and Cindy Miller of Fresno, CA; her brother Jerry Carr of Albuquerque, NM, four grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and numerous cousins, nieces, nephews and family. Betty was preceded in death by her first husband Alban B.
