June 22, 1924 - December 18, 2008

No services are scheduled at this time for Bill J. Simmons who died Thursday, Dec. 18, 2008 at his home in Roswell. His ashes will be interred at a later date in the Claude, Texas Cemetery beside his first wife, Molly, and near his parents. Bill was born in Okmulgee, OK to 'Gabe' and 'Tommie' Simmons June 22, 1924. He served in the Army Air Corp during WWII as an optics specialist. His early career was in aerospace serving as an engineer on the Apollo Project. His later career involved teaching and research at the Air Force Academy. Bill earned a BS and Masters degrees in Engineering Physics from Oklahoma University. Bill is survived by his son, Dr. Robert M. Simmons and his wife, Karin, of Escalante, Utah and by his wife of 20 years, Dorothy; Dorothy's children, Judy Duke, Mike Campbell, Chad Brown of Texas and Lee Brown of Wisconsin; 9 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren; and his walking and faithful pal, 'Ginger'.
