Graveside services for Brent Bullock, 42, of Roswell will be held at 10 am, Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at South Park Cemetery. A memorial service will be held at 11 am after the graveside at First Baptist Church with Matt Brooks officiating. Brent passed away Saturday, September 19, 2009 after a courageous fight against cancer. Brent was born July 20, 1967 to Jimmy Darrel Bullock and Loretta House Bullock in Roswell. He and his wife Lisa Locker were married September 3, 1988 in Roswell, N.M. He served in the United States Air Force receiving many awards and honors; Commendation medal, Desert Storm, Achievements medal, Desert Shield, Airman of the Quarter, McChord AFB, Airman of the month, McChord AFB, Nomination for NCO of the Quarter, McChord AFB, Good Conduct medal, marksmanship medals. Brent was a Desert Storm Veteran. He was a graduate of NMSU, he taught at Deming High School and Crownpoint Institute of Technology. Brent was employed at P.V.A.C.D. as a Water Resource Specialist and Superintendent. He also received the Outstanding Conservationist Award from NM Association of Conservation Districts, Lower Watershed Alliance, NM Water Dialogue and State Water Planning. Brent worked closely with legislators and conservation organizations to develop water management programs. He is survived by his wife Lisa of the family home, his three children: Houston, Wyatt and Bailey, his parents, Jim and Loretta Bullock; one sister, Kelly and her children: Caleb and Kiefer Ryno; one brother Andrew and his wife Sabrina and their children: Lauren, Ethan and

Emelia Bullock and numerous aunts, uncles and cousins. Brent was preceded in death by his grandparents; D. Houston and Ruth Riley Bullock ,Andrew and Tennie Baldock House.
