Burl was born on June 14, 1925 to Harvey Ernest Wilkerson and Martha Jane Elkins Wilkerson in Temple, Oklahoma. He spent his adult life in the United States Reserves and Army, retiring with the rank of Colonel. During his civilian career, Burl obtained his Eagle Scout award, was a troop leader and received an Emeritus Award for 30 years of distinguished service with the Boy Scouts of America. Additionally, Burl served as a member of the March of Dimes, and was a lifetime member of the Optimist Club. During his time with the Optimist Club he served as Club President and Club Governor, in addition to several other positions. As a young man, Burl received a Distinguished Service Award from the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce. Burl is survived by his children, Dona K. Jones of Columbia, MO, Patricia R. Nebelsick and her husband Ron of Fort Collins, CO, Burl James Wilkerson II of Sugar Land, TX, and Daniel Olin Wilkerson and his wife Cynda, of Houston, TX; two brothers, Jack Wilkerson of Roswell, NM and Bob Wilkerson of Honduras, Central America; two sisters-in-law, Goldie Wilkerson of Albuquerque, NM and Clara Wilkerson of Denton, TX; thirteen grandchildren and eleven great-grandchildren, along with numerous nieces, nephews, and friends.
