A private memorial service will be held for Burlington Jones, 86, of Roswell at Sunset Villa Nursing Home Thursday, March 10, 2011 at 3:00 pm. Burlington Wesley Jones passed away on Sunday, March 6, 2011 at Sunset Villa Nursing Home in Roswell, NM. He was born in Stayton, TX on January 1, 1925. Growing up in Stayton he learned to play the trumpet at age of 9 and played in his first band at the "Cotton Club" at age 13 having his mother "Audrey" chaperone. He left college at Texas Tech and joined the Navy. While in the service he was a radio/bombardier who had flown with Ensign Gay, the only survivor of Torpedo Squadron 8 from the Battle of Midway. After the war he married the love of his life Nancile Hart in Carlsbad, NM. They lived in Ruidoso where he played the Trumpet in a big band. He preceded her in death. Together they have two sons and one daughter: Wesley and his wife Angie of ABQ and one son Benjie in OK, Frank of Roswell and his son Jason of OH, Jan Hinkle and husband Don of Roswell and their son Danny of Roswell, and five grandchildren. His parents and sister preceded him in death. His main occupation was selling cars, and playing the trumpet. He obtained his pilot's license and enjoyed flying his small two seater plane.
