On Wednesday, January 18, 2012, at 10:15 am., Dogie left this earth and went into the arms of his heavenly father, after a short bout with cancer. He was at home, surrounded by his loving family and dear friends. We are deeply grateful for Vista Care Hospice and all their wonderful staff for being there for Dogie and the family.

Dogie was a lifelong resident of Roswell, from the age of 5, having been born in Portales, NM, on May 29, 1936. While in the Navy, he proudly served in the Korean War. He served in national defense and for the China service.

Dogie is survived by his wife and best friend of 44 years, Mary, his daughter, Robin Casady, of Roswell, grandson, Bryan Massey, of Las Cruces, granddaughter, Tamara Davis, of Melrose, and great-granddaughter, Julia Davis. He is also survived by his sister, Kay Moleski (husband Paul), of Sebastian, Florida, brother, Ross Hare (wife Louise), of Roswell, and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.
