Obituary for Charles "Chuck" Miller

Chuck Miller, 82, of Roswell, NM passed away at home on Saturday, February 4, 2012 surrounded by his loved ones as he and his wife Katie observed their 58th wedding anniversary.

He was born on September 19, 1929 in Dallas, TX to Charles Albert Miller Sr. and Gertrude Cawthon Miller who both preceded him in death.

After serving in the Air Force during the Korean War, he returned to work in Louisiana. He was always proud to be a Veteran and the contribution he made to his country.

Chuck and Katie met in Houma, Louisiana and were married on February 4, 1954. Throughout their 58 years of marriage, Chucks work took them throughout the United States, allowing him to enjoy his passion of fishing and golf. Their travels also provided their family cherished friendships that still remain to this day.

Chuck and Katie remained in Roswell after Chuck retired from Transwestern Pipeline with almost 30 years to his credit, in the safety field. Retirement brought them the opportunity to volunteer.
