On February 21, 1961, Clarence was born to McKenzie Cheadle and Willie Mae Webb in Roswell, New Mexico. He graduated from High School and later joined the U.S. Army in Ft. Jackson on 29-JUL-80 and was Honorably discharged on 21-JUL-83 as a Motor Transport Operator and Light-Wheel Vehicle Power Generation Mechanic. During Clarence's military service, he was awarded an Army Service Ribbon, Expert Badge (M-16 Rifle) Bar, and an Expert Badge with Hand Grenade Bar. He was a proud Veteran whose heart was to serve his country. Clarence loved going to church, he always put God first in his life. He was a member of Church on the Move, where he was a door greeter. Clarence was part of a prison ministry group. He was a "Dallas Cowboy" fan, who enjoyed watching them play on Sundays. Clarence was also a big fan of the "Los Angeles Lakers." He loved having family gatherings and spending time with his grandkids. Clarence enjoyed watching his kids and grandkids play sports, he was their #1 fan. He was truly loved and will be greatly missed by all who knew him.
