Clifford C. Gonzalez Jr. "C.C." passed away Wednesday, November 11, 2015 at his home, after a long fight with cancer, he was 74. God finally got his Mexican Plasterer. A memorial service is scheduled for Saturday, November 14, at 1 pm at the chapel of Anderson Bethany Funeral Home.
