Dale worked many jobs early in life eventually managing his own Texaco Service Station in the early 1990’s after the encouragement of his Father-in-Law Jess Robinson. However Dale’s true passion was paint and drywall and in 1993 he was able to fully follow his dream after obtaining his contractors license and starting Dale Davis Construction which then transitioned to Dale Davis Painting, LLC over the

years. Dale worked hard to establish a name and reputation for himself in Eddy County and Southeast New Mexico doing many commercial painting projects. In addition Dale was one of the first individuals along with his crew in New Mexico to begin pouring acrylic floors. Dale devoted his life to his work, but also enjoyed hunting and the outdoors with his long time right hand man Kevin Crouch.
