“ My condolences to the Munoz family. I served with Daniel in 1974 and 1975 at atsugi naval air facility in Japan. We were the u.s. marine security detachment there.there was only about 62 marines in the security detachment.i left Japan in late January 1976 since my enlistment was to expire in a week. It was a 24 month tour for most of us.another marine I knew from our detachment got stationed at el Toro marine corps air station in 1976. He contacted me since I lived close to el Toro. When I visited him at his off base housing he told me that Daniel was here at el Toro assigned to the base horse stables. I went another day to look for him. Sure enough he was in the horse corral with a horse.daniel was surprised to see me. He told me he would volunteer to help out at the stables.the base general's wife was a horse rider. When she noticed that Daniel knew how to handle horse's she had her husband permanently reassign Daniel there.he wore his blue jeans to work.i remember in Japan he wore cowboy boots off duty. I lost track of Daniel and the other marine I knew there.i remember one day in Japan daniel,me and another marine were on the electric train.i don't remember where we were going. By chance we went past a pasture with about 8 cows.that's the only time I ever saw cows in japan.the other marine with us said the air stinks here.daniel replied it smells good it reminds me of home.i had to laugh.i grew up in corona .ca. My cousins lived in the town next to corona called Norco. Norco is a rural town with horse's cows chickens and fowl.it is called horse town u.s.a. .I have a funny mischief story about the time we were stationed in japan.one night me Daniel and another marine were at enlisted man's club drinking till about 11 45 p.m. or 12 45 a.m. we were very tipsy. Behind the club was a push cart that had vehicle tires on it. Me and the other marine got on it and I told Daniel take us to the barracks which is where we lived. Daniel got behind the push bar and took off. We were yelling and laughing about our charriot ride.about half way there Daniel pooped out of energy.i then took over and took off running pulling the cart.i'm guessing it was about 150 to 200 yards to our barracks.i just abandoned the cart on the street near our barracks.we never got caught for that.i still keep in touch with two marine veterans I served with in japan.both live in
