Although Danny was born with Cerebral Palsy, had diabetes, and many other problems, he made the best out of everything he did. For instance, he graduated from Roswell High School, worked as a greeter for many years at Kmart, participated in the Special

Olympics, actively was involved in his community, and even ran for the Roswell City Council in the 1980s. Danny lost by four hundred and fifty-eight votes, but it wasn't for lack of hard work. He was an inspiration to all that knew him because of his positive attitude, upbeat personality, and most of all, his strong faith in God and humanity. Danny's surviving family are incredibly grateful for all of his caretakers at Tobosa Developmental Services in Roswell and to all the medical professionals who worked so diligently with him.

Danny taught all of us many things including, how always to keep a good attitude and try hard no matter what life throws at you, and how tough it can be. He taught us love and tolerance for all of God's children. He taught us to forgive because we all are forgiven. He knew the importance of asking for forgiveness, not only of others but most importantly, of the Lord God. Danny loved Jesus and was a member of Grace Community Church, 935 West Mescalero, Roswell, NM, where his services will be held on Thursday, February 28, 2019, at 10:00 AM, with Senior Pastor Rick Hale officiating.
