On October 31st, 1949, Dan was born to Thomas Edison and Eva Mae Andrews in New Orleans, LA. A military family, they lived at several American bases before settling in El Paso, TX. Dan attended the University of Texas El Paso where he earned his Bachelor's Degree in English Literature in December 1971 and joined the management training program for SS Kresge (Kmart Corporation). He married Leslie Ann Holcomb on June 3rd, 1972, at Grace United Methodist Church in El Paso.

Dan managed Kmart's in several western states prior to transferring to the Roswell Kmart around 1983. He left Kmart to work for TMC/NovaBUS in the late 80's and taught several introductory classes as an adjunct teacher at ENMU Roswell. Dan worked as Purchasing Director for Leprino Foods Company where he finished his career. Dan retired from Leprino Foods 2018. Dan was an avid sports fan and devoted much time to the community of Roswell coaching little league football and baseball, helping to organize and serving as head official for Gus Macker Basketball and Hike It and Spike It flag football tournaments. He also trained and scheduled baseball umpires for the

city and the school district for several seasons.

Dan is survived by a loving family; Leslie, wife of 54 years, daughter Carrie (Jimmy) Furrow, son Brian (Lorena) Andrews, many (15) grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren, his brother Ron, brothers-in-law, Bob and Doug (Dee), nieces Kim, Rhonda, Sonya, Jennifer, and Shannon and their families.
