



## Donald Coppock

October 29, 1916 - June 6, 2015

Donald Coppock was a man of wisdom, patience, and shared stories spanning a generation. He was born to Harley and Hazel Coppock in 1916 in Pleasant Hill, Ohio. His mother's early death when he was 2 brought his aunt, Minnie, to raise him to adulthood as his stepmother.

Upon graduation from Newton Township School in 1934, he entered the United States Air Force where he served in both World War II and the Korean War. In 1949, Donald married Ruth Orr in Roswell, NM where they settled. During their 58 years there, Donald pursued a career with Southwest Public Service where after 29 years of service, he retired in 1981. Donald and Ruth were active members of West Minister Presbyterian Church in Roswell and Donald was a Free Mason for 74 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, siblings, and his wife.

Donald is survived by many nieces and nephews.
