A memorial service for Doug Haynes, 70, of Roswell, will be held at 2 pm Saturday, Nov. 10, 2012 at Anderson-Bethany Funeral Home Chapel with Cecil Kimberlin officiating. Doug passed away on Wednesday, Nov. 7, 2012. Family viewing will be held on Saturday from 8-10 am with public viewing from 10am – 2pm.

Doug was born March 8, 1942 to Archie “Speedy” and Ellen Dean Haynes in Hobbs, NM at Dr. Kennedy’s clinic. He was the second of four children, growing up in Monument, NM at the HAT Ranch. Doug graduated from Hobbs High School and went to NMSU in Las Cruces, NM and ENMU in Portales, NM. He served our country as a sergeant in the National Guard from Dec. 12, 1963- May 27, 1967. Following his service, Doug held several jobs in the oilfield, retiring from Phillips Petroleum in 1999 as Superintendent of the Andrews, TX area. From 1999 until the present date, Doug was the owner of Ruidoso Septic Service, a business started by his brother, Bruce Haynes. Doug is survived by his mother, Dean Haynes of Ruidoso; three siblings; Carolyn Dean Mathis of Mathis, TX; Bruce Gene Haynes of Ruidoso Downs, NM and Kenneth Bryan Haynes of Ruidoso, NM; three children, Danny R. Haynes of Capitan, NM; Devene Haynes of Roswell, NM and Tomi Lene’t Haynes also of Roswell, NM; eleven grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his father, “Speedy” Haynes, daughter, Chez’Ren’e Haynes and his grandson, Michael Nicklaus Cannon.
