January 17, 1940 - March 5, 2013

We would like to give special thanks to Beth Hunt, Heather Bragg, Tina Bragg for their love and care during these trying times, as well as Randel Salley.

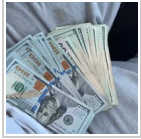
