During that time He worked for twenty years as a licensed Sheet Metalist and Plumber, and for sixteen of those years, he also worked for Ms. Eileen Grooms, and Eastern New Mexico Medical Center for two years as a Maintenance Technician.

He absolutely loved his wife and kids, grandkids, and great-grandkids. They were the joy of his life. His favorite thing was having his family together, usually centered around his famous brisket, ribs, and menudo. Holidays were a favorite time because he knew everyone would be together, and the sound of laughter from his family would fill the room. His kids and grandkids could do no wrong in his eyes, as he would defend them when they got in “trouble” with grandma! Dad loved his sons-in-law, Jason and Will, and appreciated them helping with tasks that he was no longer able to do. But he REALLY loved Jason and Will for being good husbands to his daughters and good dads to his grandkids.

Eddie enjoyed taking a cruise to visit his brother-in-law, Eddie, for some good laughs. He used to look forward to weekend breakfasts with his good friend, Joe Estrada. His favorite hobbies included working, hunting with his sons and sons-in-law, cruising with his wife, and cooking outside on the disco.

He really missed being able to go to church, but on Sunday morning, December 9, 2018, he stepped into the greatest worship service ever and joined the angels to celebrate Jesus his Savior!
