



## Edna Faye Ervin

August 1, 1936 - August 17, 2013

Graveside services for Edna Faye Ervin will be held August 20, 2013 at 2:00 pm at South Park Cemetery with Gentiva Hospice Chaplain Cecil Kimberlin officiating. She will be buried beside her mother.

Faye was born to Thomas G. and Odessa Ervin on August 1, 1936 in Hamlin, TX. She moved to Roswell at the age of three and attended Roswell schools graduating from Roswell High in 1954. Upon graduation Faye chose the secretarial field as her profession and pursued that career while living in Roswell, San Francisco, Los Angeles, Las Vegas and Utah. Her hobbies included drawing and crocheting; she also had a love for NASCAR and spent her Sunday afternoons watching races. She returned to Roswell in 1991 and remained her until her death.
