Edward Keith David passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by his loving family on Wednesday, October 23, 2024. Eddie was honored with a Memorial Service, Saturday, October 26, 2024, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Roswell, New Mexico where he has remained a dedicated member since 1967.

Eddie always loved life stories of people who were struggling to work and make their life better and if he saw they had innate tenacity and drive, he would always give them unprecedented amounts of money letting them know he was impressed by their story and to keep reaching their goals. 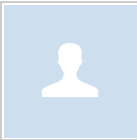

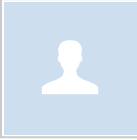
