After graduating, he enlisted in the United States Army. Mike was with the 11th Armored Cavalry out of Fort Sam Houston, in San Antonio, Texas, where he was first deployed and sent to Vietnam. While serving his country he was wounded and later received 5 metals: a National Defense Metal, Vietnam Service Metal, Purple Heart Metal, Combat Medical Badge (EMT), and an Expert Badge M-16 rifle metal. Prior to his retirement, his occupation was an EMT.

Mike is preceded in death by his wife, Marcella Marquis; his parents, Frank Marquis Sr. and Petra Marquis; grandparents: William Marquis, Grace Murdock, Melcor Chavez, and Andrea Montoya; and his nephew, Frank Marquis III.
