



## Elizabeth Burnett

May 10, 1927 - July 14, 2012

She passed away on July 14 at ENMMC following a brief illness.

Betty was born on May 10, 1927, to Adelaide and Clarence Miller in Rochester, NY. She graduated from Mercy High School in Rochester and went on to attend St. Joseph College in Emmitsburg, MD. She married George Burnett on August 23, 1947. They raised their family in Rochester and then relocated to Roswell in 1974, where they owned and operated a hobby shop. Following George's death on November 18, 1976, Betty worked as a teacher at Job Corps. She was very involved at her church, Assumption Catholic Church, with the Altar and Rosary Society, Catholic Daughters, and as a Eucharistic Minister. Betty also volunteered with St Peters Community Kitchen, St. Mary's Hospital Auxiliary, and ENMMC Auxiliary thrift shop. She was awarded the Sertoma Club Service to Mankind Award in 1993 and was the Catholic Daughter of the Year in 1997. She worked throughout her life in a very quiet and loving manner to be of service to others in honor of her Lord. In addition to volunteering, Betty was an active member of Senior Circle and the Roswell Adult Center, an avid angel collector, loved listening to opera, and had traveled extensively to Europe, the Orient, and throughout the United States and Caribbean. She loved to read and was a devoted Friend of the

Roswell Public Library.

Betty is survived by one daughter, Johanna McNeil, and her husband John of Port Charlotte, FL; nephew Paul Kreutzer and nieces Margaret Roets and Joyce Hoyt, all of the Rochester area; niece Chris Collins of Denver, CO; and sister-in-law Dorothy Chicoratich of Burlington, Washington.

Betty was preceded in death by her husband; her son, John Burnett; and sister, Georgene Kreutzer.
