### Obituary for Elizabeth Darwin Manning

Family memorial services will be held for Elizabeth Darwin Manning, 88, of Roswell, New Mexico, who passed away Sunday, April 22, 2007, at Mission Arch Care Center.

Elizabeth was born on June 6, 1918 to John D. Manning and Mabel E. Bergen Manning in New Brunswick, N.J. She worked for the ration board during World War II, was office manager for Dr. Anthony Pellican M.D. of New Brunswick until 1960 when Dr. Pellican retired. From 1960 until 1981, she worked for Dr. Michael Brody M.D., an ophthalmologist. Elizabeth was a member of the Ruth Chapter #12 of the Eastern Star in New Jersey for over fifty years. In 1981, at age 65, she retired to St. Augustine, Florida. In February of 2003, she moved to Roswell to be with her cousin, Jane Ann Ackart-Caprio and her husband, Stephen Caprio. Elizabeth's cousin Jane Ann Ackart-Caprio preceded her in death on March 19, 2006.

Elizabeth is survived by her cousin-in-law, Stephen Caprio of Roswell.
