



## Enrique Nunez

August 11, 1960 - January 4, 2024

Enrique (Henry) Nunez suddenly and unexpectedly passed away on January 4, 2024.

Henry was born in Carlsbad, New Mexico, on August 11, 1960, to Consuelo Terrazas and Alfredo Nunez. After graduating from Goddard High School, Henry began his long career in manufacturing.
