Espiridion "Steve" Bachicha, 81, passed away on Sunday, November 9th 2025 in Roswell, NM.

There will be a rosary at Anderson Bethany on Monday, November 24th at 6:00 p.m. Funeral Services will be held at St. John's Catholic Church on Tuesday, November 25th at 10:00 a.m. Interment will follow at General Douglas L. McBride Veteran Cemetery.

Steve was born on June 30, 1944 to Espiridion and Julianita Bachicha in Albuquerque, NM. He was raised and attended school in Roswell, NM. He enlisted in United States Army in 1968. He served in Vietnam and was awarded a Purple Heart for wounds received in combat.
