Graveside services for Eudell White will be held Thursday, March 20, 2008 at 11:00 AM at South Park Cemetery with Marvin Roberts officiating. Eudell passed away Tuesday, March 18, 2008 at Mission Arch Care Center. Eudell was born July 3, 1922 to W.B. and Eva (Houx) Durham in Lake View, Texas. They later came to Roswell and homestead 35 miles north of town. Eudell's father, W.B. Durham, drove the school bus for the Chaves County School where Eudell graduated in 1939 and later from Lea's Beauty College. Shortly afterwards she worked in her own beauty shop. After retiring she traveled with her husband, Dale L. White Sr. wherever his job took them. She married Dale L. White, Sr. on December 10, 1954 in Carlsbad, NM; he survives her of the family home. She was a member of Bykota Baptist Church. Eudell is preceded in death by her mother and father, two sisters, Zelda Durham and Alice Derring, two brothers, E.L.
