Between 1947 and 1952 he worked for several road contractors as a supervisor, in 1952-1961, Eugene worked for Republic Natural Gas in Refugio and in 1961 he transferred to Guymon, OK. He also worked with his friend Alton Burke fixing televisions and other electronics, he also did this at his home for friends and he retired in 1986. Eugene enjoyed doing anything that was electrical or mechanical, he loved the outdoors, gardening and Rving. He attended the Indian Pow Wow's in Anadarko, OK every year, and our National Parks.
