Lee, Jr. on September 16, 1936, in Carlsbad, NM. And most important, they gave their lives to Christ in 1938. They enjoyed almost 73 years together before his Home-going in August 2009. She was "almost 96," (as she would proudly tell anyone who asked) as she recently danced her way into her glorified body.
