Frank Jean Tuffs, 91 of Roswell passed away Saturday, October 15, 2011 in Roswell.

Frank was born July 6, 1920 in Deer Creek, Minnesota to Frank Monroe and Helen (Packard) Tuffs. He married Martha Randall on September 4, 1954. He served in the Air Force and went to work for Sandia National Laboratories for 24 years until he retired. Frank lived in Albuquerque before moving to Roswell. In Albuquerque, he was a Deacon and Elder at First Presbyterian Church where he had been a 50 year member. Frank was a very skilled woodcarver and talented furniture builder.
