Obituary for George T. Weitz

After moving to Roswell in 1989, George was employed at Eastern New Mexico University-Roswell as the "Wire Guy", responsible for installation of all

computers and networking campus wide, He was also an Instructor of Computer Science, Data and Computer Networking. He loved his time at Eastern and all of the staff and students that he worked with. He especially enjoyed mentoring work/study students in his office. George was a people-person and loved everyone. Prior to his employment at ENMU-R, George was employed with Pacific Bell/AT&T for 32 years. He was active in the Communications Workers of America union as a Union Steward and was extremely involved in providing for the CWA employees in his district. Upon his diagnosis, George was able to spend his final days at home due to the love, care and concern of all that worked at VistaCare Home Health.
