A memorial service to honor Georgia's life will be held on December 2, 2023, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm at Anderson-Bethany Funeral Home.

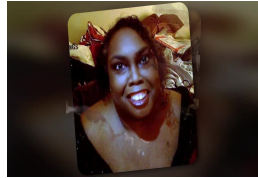
"I look in the mirror, but I don't see me.
