



Glenn Latimer

May 30, 1925 - January 18, 2014

Chaves County native and longtime resident Glenn Latimer, 88, died Saturday, January 18 in an Albuquerque hospital following a short illness.

Glenn was born in Dexter on May 30, 1925 to Johnnie Parks Latimer and Earl A. Latimer. He graduated from Dexter High School in 1940 where he was valedictorian. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Army (Hellcats Unit, serving the United States on the French and German borders). He was wounded and received the Purple Heart. He and his older brother, Earl A. Latimer, Jr., M.D., both served in WWII and were able to meet on furlough in London and Germany during the war.

After the war, Glenn returned to Roswell and joined his father in the barbering business in Hagerman and Dexter. He became the owner of the Dexter Barbershop and pool hall where he worked until his retirement in the late 1990s.

He was an avid reader and historian.

Glenn married Millie Taylor in 1958. She died in 1973.

He is survived by his grandchildren: Ryan Latimer of Roswell, Melanie Latimer of Denver, and Liana Latimer of Roswell. He is also survived by his step

daughter, Connie Taylor Lee of Oklahoma, grandson Gordon Allen and his wife Valerie, and a great grandson Grady Allen; his sister, Dianne Address, and her husband Ottie of Dexter; and many nieces and nephews.

Glenn was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Millie; his daughter Jo Denise Latimer; his step-daughter Mary Lee Taylor; his brother, Earl A. Latimer, Jr., M.D., and his wife Pat; and his sister Audre Latimer King and her husband Roy O. King, Jr.
