Guadalupe Gonzales Luevano, known and loved by many as Lupe, entered eternal life on April 23, 2026.

Lupe Luevano was born on September 7, 1948, to María Luisa Gonzales Luevano and Margarito Luevano. He grew up in Dexter, New Mexico, where he built lifelong roots and memories. He proudly graduated from Dexter High School in 1967. As the oldest of ten children, he carried a strong sense of responsibility, leadership, and love for his family from a very young age; qualities that stayed with him throughout his life.

Lupe proudly served the United States Army as a Vietnam War veteran. His dedication and sacrifice reflect the strength and honor that defined who he was.

He was born a Catholic and was an active member of St. Peter’s Catholic Church, where his faith served as a guiding foundation throughout his life. He was kind, warm and loving. He had a special way of making people feel loved, calling everyone his “hitos’ and ‘hitas’.” To him, no one was a stranger- everyone became family.

Until his very last day, he held firmly to his faith trusting in God's promise of resurrection.

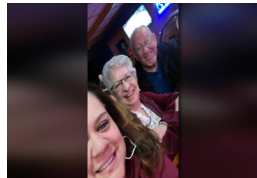

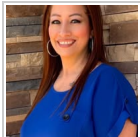
