Obituary for Helen Hays

Martha Helen Merritt Hays was born in Tokio, Texas, on May 19, 1914 to James and Ella James Merritt. She died on December 14, 2008, in Brownfield, Texas, at the age of 94. Helen married Clyde Clement Hays on December 23, 1933. Clyde and Helen raised their children on a sheep ranch 75 miles north of Roswell, New Mexico. Helen cooked, sewed, helped “work” sheep and helped send their children to college by moving to Roswell and working in a fabric store. Helen was an active member of South Main Church of Christ and Country Club Church of Christ in Roswell. Clyde preceded Helen in death in 1972. Her siblings, Louise Merritt, Don Merritt and Gladys Fisher, a great-grandson, Cooper Tugman also preceded her in death. She is survived by her brother, Jack, and two sisters, Mary Cloe Jackson and Eloise Drake. Helen’s children include Maxine and Earl Hammer of Edmond, Oklahoma, Bill and Judy Hays of Capitan, New Mexico, Robert and Sandi Hays of Pueblo, Colorado, Joe and Glo Hays of Tahoka, TX and Weedon Hays of Brownfield, TX.
