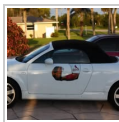

We were sorry to hear of your Mother's passing. My name name is Theresa Dugan Tucci and my sister's name is Dorothy Dugan Ryan. We were both friends of your Mother. We all went to the one room school house in Crossingville and would like to share some of our memories. Dorothy remembers at school she and Iliene taking turns cranking the old Victrola so we could have music. I remember Iliene bringing her lunch to school. Her sandwiches were made with homemade bread and they looked so good. Our parents had the Red & White grocery store in Crossingville and Tau's farm wasn't that far away. They lived on Pont Road. Dorothy remembers walking to the farm where they played in the big white barn. Mr. Tau always planted and raised peanuts. I remember during WW2 Iliene, Dorothy and I, with our burlap sacks, going through the field to pick milkweed pods for the army. We were told they used them to make parachutes. They weighted our sacks but I don't remember if we got paid but we felt it was our duty for the cause. We knew your Aunts and Uncle Ralph and Margret. They were good friends of my husband. They all belonged to the Grange. We will always remember the Tau family. With many wonderful memories—Theresa and Dorothy.
