He volunteered as a member of Chaves County Fire & EMS Sertoma. James was deeply loved and will be profoundly missed not only by his family and friends but by all those blessed enough to have known him.

James enjoyed singing karaoke and watching all sports with his friends, no sound needed, especially the Dallas Cowboys and Philadelphia Phillies. They were his favorite teams. After twenty-eight years of dedicated service for the Roswell Fire Department, James retired.
