James Lloyd Browning was born on June 17, 1928, in Cold Springs, Kentucky to Pearl and Frances Browning and passed away June 14, 2025, just three days shy of his 97th birthday.

In his early years he worked as a truck driver and heavy equipment operator, a skill that he carried on to the US Army when he enlisted in 1950. During his time in the US Army, he served in the Korean War in the 62nd Engineer Construction Battalion.
