She attended grammar school and junior high in Burbank. When her family moved to Pasadena she attended the Pasadena Academy, and then took classes at Pasadena Nazarene College. She excelled in voice, primarily in choir and solo.

Jeanne married Doyle Cozzens on November 23, 1953 in Pasadena. At the time of her death, they had been married 56+ years. She worked for many years as a business manager for a large auto dealership. She was known for exacting standards of book-keeping and accounting. Her true passion, however, was the study of the Bible. From the early 1960s, she attended large and small study groups. She would often take her children and later, her grandchildren to these study groups.
