On July 4, 2020, she married the love of her life, Blake Morris Womack, in Midlothian, Texas.

In October of 2020, Blake and Jessica moved to New Mexico. She loved the clean air, small town living and of course the mountains. They resided in Roswell, New Mexico until her passing.

A devoted member of the Anglican and Episcopal Church, Jessica lived a life guided by compassion, service, and faith. She was a proud member of the Grand Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star New Mexico, where she served as Grand Librarian.
