Joe Ray Carrillo was born on March 5, 1966, to Mary Priscilla and Facundo Carrillo in Roswell, New Mexico. He attended Roswell High School and graduated in 1984. He enlisted in the United States Navy from January 1987 to January 1991. Joe Ray went on to earn his Doctor of Pharmacy degree in 2001. He had a profound relationship with our Lord, and you could often find him with his Bible reading early every morning. Growing up he enjoyed playing basketball, football, and baseball. As an adult he enjoyed hunting, playing pool, riding his motorcycle, and learning new things. One of his favorite past times was spending time with his grandchildren and watching them in their various activities, Joe Ray was employed as a pharmacist throughout New Mexico and had a special relationship with every patient he served. 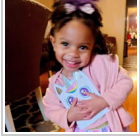

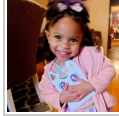
