During Joe's military service, he was given the Truck Driver Award and several certifications. He was the beloved husband of Alice Hicks, whom he married on December 12, 2009, in Levelland, Texas.

Prior to retirement, Joe worked as a Heavy Equipment Operator in the coal mine industry, where he received an award of recognition. Joe was a member of the Washington Chapel and was also a member of the Mason Pecos Valley Lodge #7. Joe enjoyed volunteering for the Lions Club and the Mission Arch Care Center. His gifts of compassion were characteristics of his nature; his

heart was for service.

All who were lucky enough to have known Joe knew him as a kind, generous, gentle soul who liked to joke around. 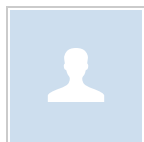
