markets and traveled around New Mexico. They had a church home and loved to play tennis and horseshoes. Most of all, they enjoyed being together. John found the love of his life late in life, but he said, "I finally found my cowgirl." Prior to retirement, John worked at Peter Piper Pizza for thirty years.
