A life celebration will be held for John Tilley, Jr., 81, of Roswell, NM, on Saturday, April 9, 2011, 11:00 am, at Anderson Bethany Funeral Home. He passed away Monday, March 28, 2011 in the comfort of his home in Roswell, NM. John Tilley, the son of Hercel and Ennis Belle Birchfield Tilley, was born September 11, 1929, in southern West Virginia in the sawmill community of Maben. He grew up in the coal mining towns of Bud-Alpoca. He enlisted into the U.S. Air Force in 1947, and in early September of 1948 flew from Goosebay, Labrador, in a B-29 Bomber with the legendary Charles A, Lindberg at the controls, to Walker Air Force Base, Roswell, New Mexico, John was assigned overseas seven times and retired in 1967 as a Master Sergeant. He enjoyed writing, coon hunting, horses, fishing, and is a past member of the Authors Guild. John is the author of The Tom Jack, Tubar and Expose: The Roswell Incident, Corona Crash. He is survived by his wife Margaret, son Larry and wife Ruth Tilley, Arlington, Texas, daughters Charlotte and husband Fred Hopper, Albuquerque; Lois and husband Rambert Waid, Roswell, 1 brother and 5 sisters, 9 grandchildren and 26 great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by wife Inez Pauline Tilley, granddaughter Bonnie Rhoades, his parents and 8 brothers and 1 sister.
