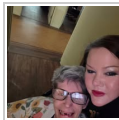

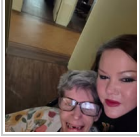
He was also married to Patricia proctor until her death in 2002.. he has 5 step children 4 girls 1 boy and numerous step grandchildren whom loved him and he loved.,
