Jose "Joe" S. Alvarez, 85, passed away on Wednesday, February 7, 2018. There will be a Viewing at Anderson Bethany Funeral Home on Thursday, February 15, 2018, 8:00 AM – 7:00 PM, followed by a Rosary at 7:00 PM. Throughout Joe's life, he was a farmer, owner of JuJu's Lounge, owned and managed KRDD Radio Station, and was co-owner of the Flamingo Club. He had an immense love for music and was an incredible dancer. Joe enjoyed socializing and made many friends throughout his life. A lifelong member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, Joe had a loving and generous heart, always willing to help others. He was a wonderful father, grandfather, great-grandfather, uncle, and friend to many. Joe was deeply loved and will be profoundly missed, not only by his family and friends, but by all those fortunate enough to have known him. 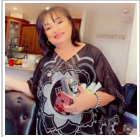

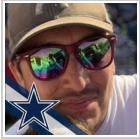
